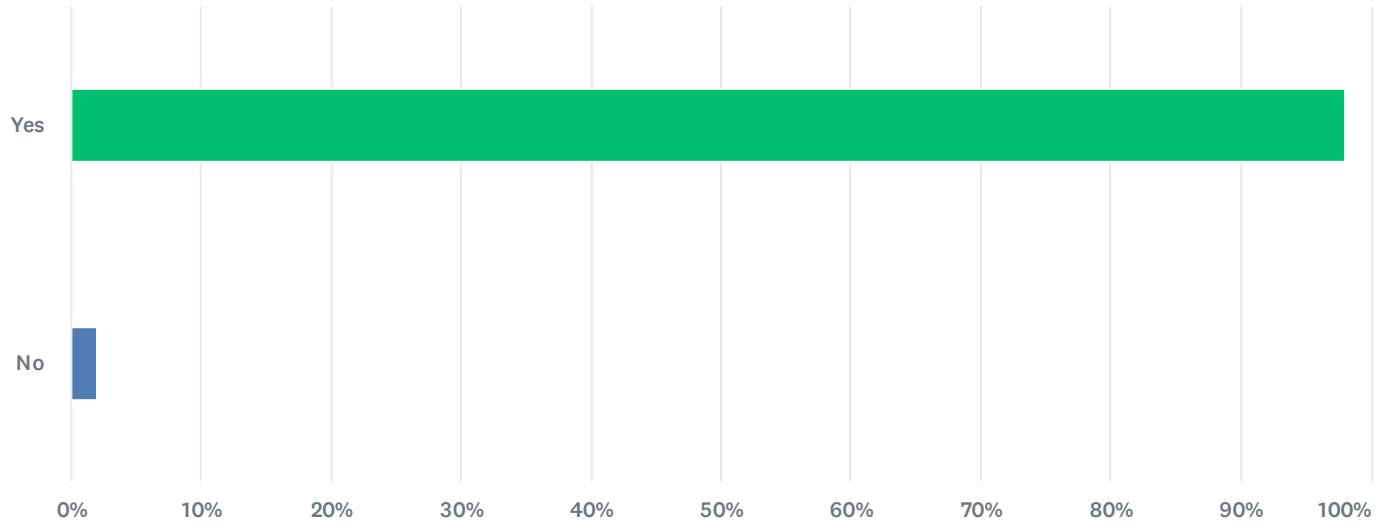

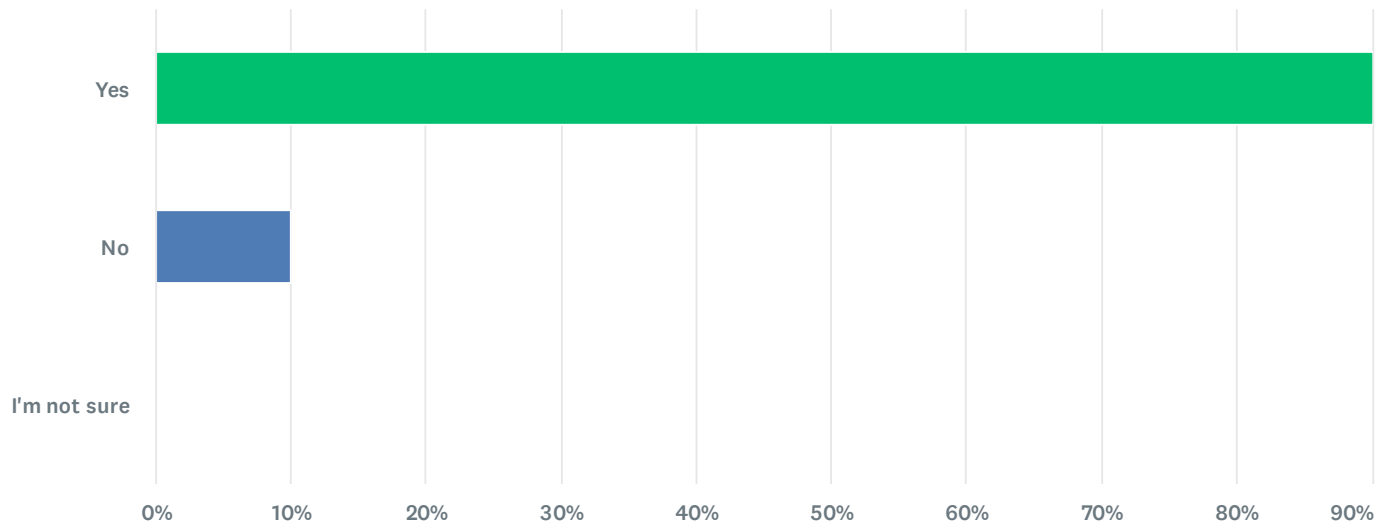
Q1 50 responses

Do you currently live in Blue Lake?



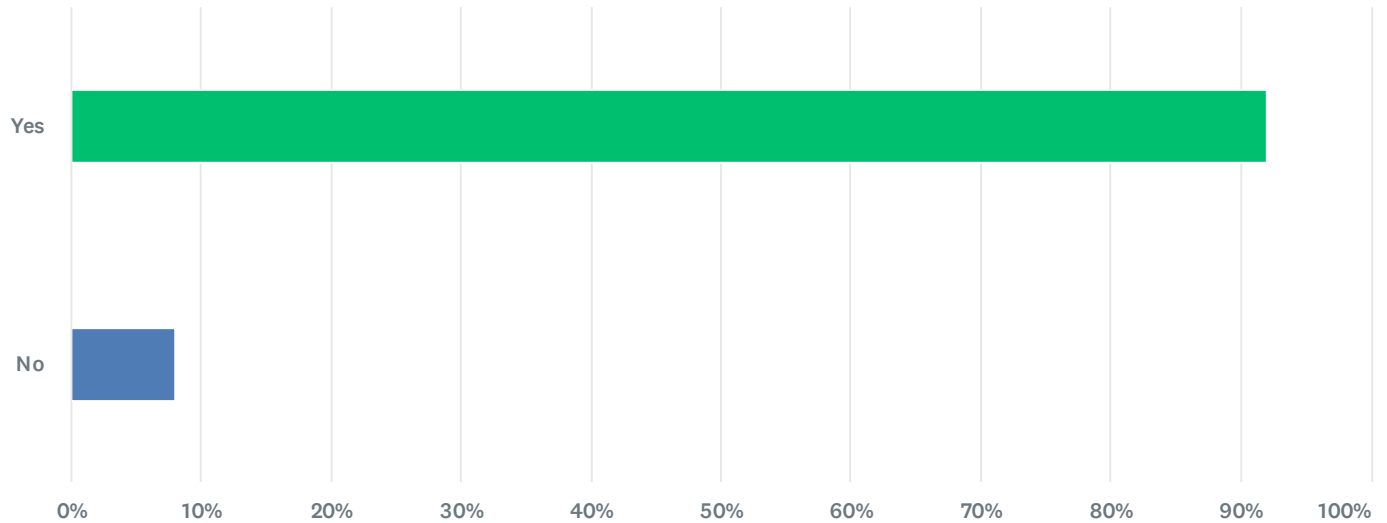
Q2 50 responses

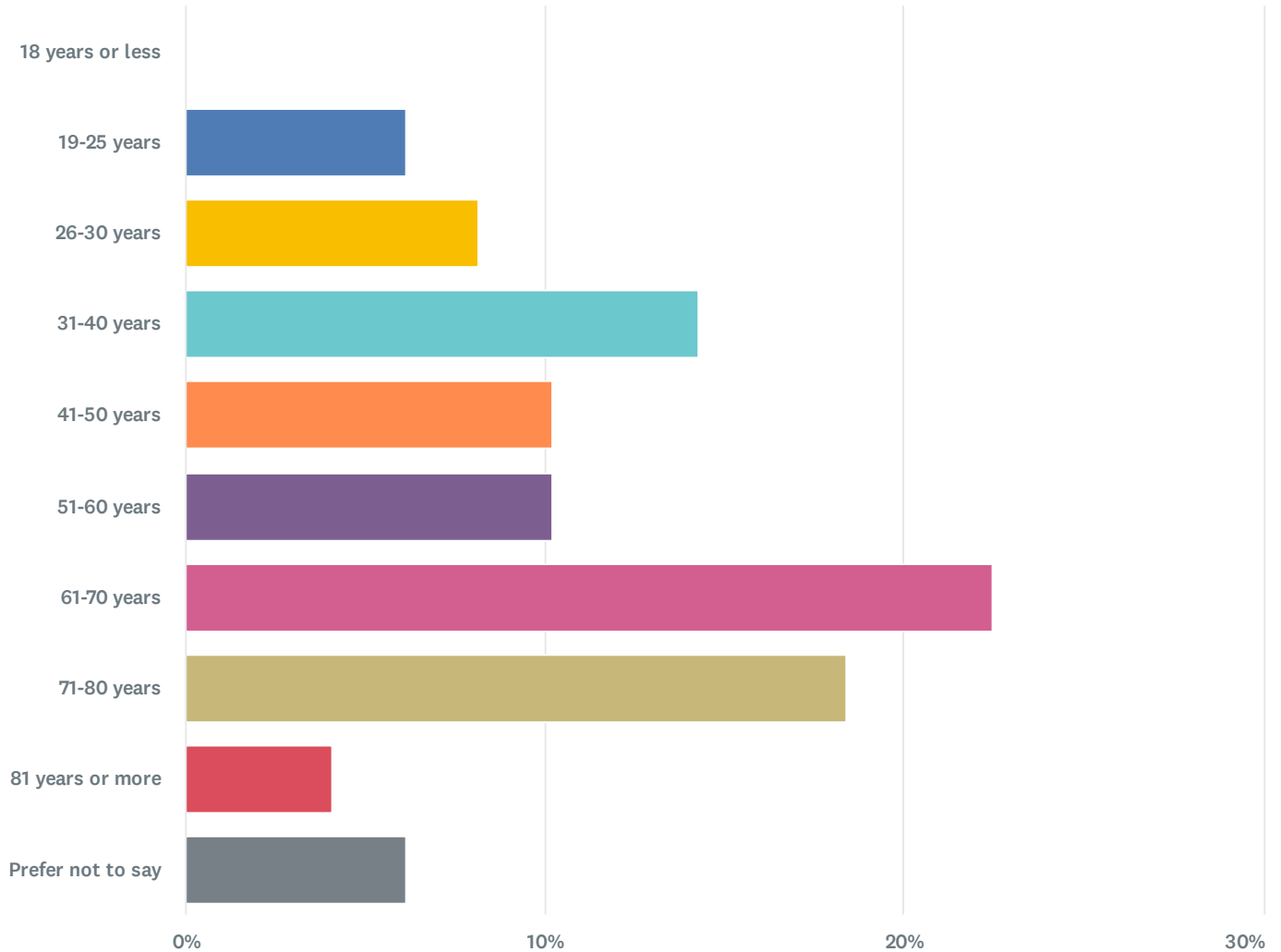

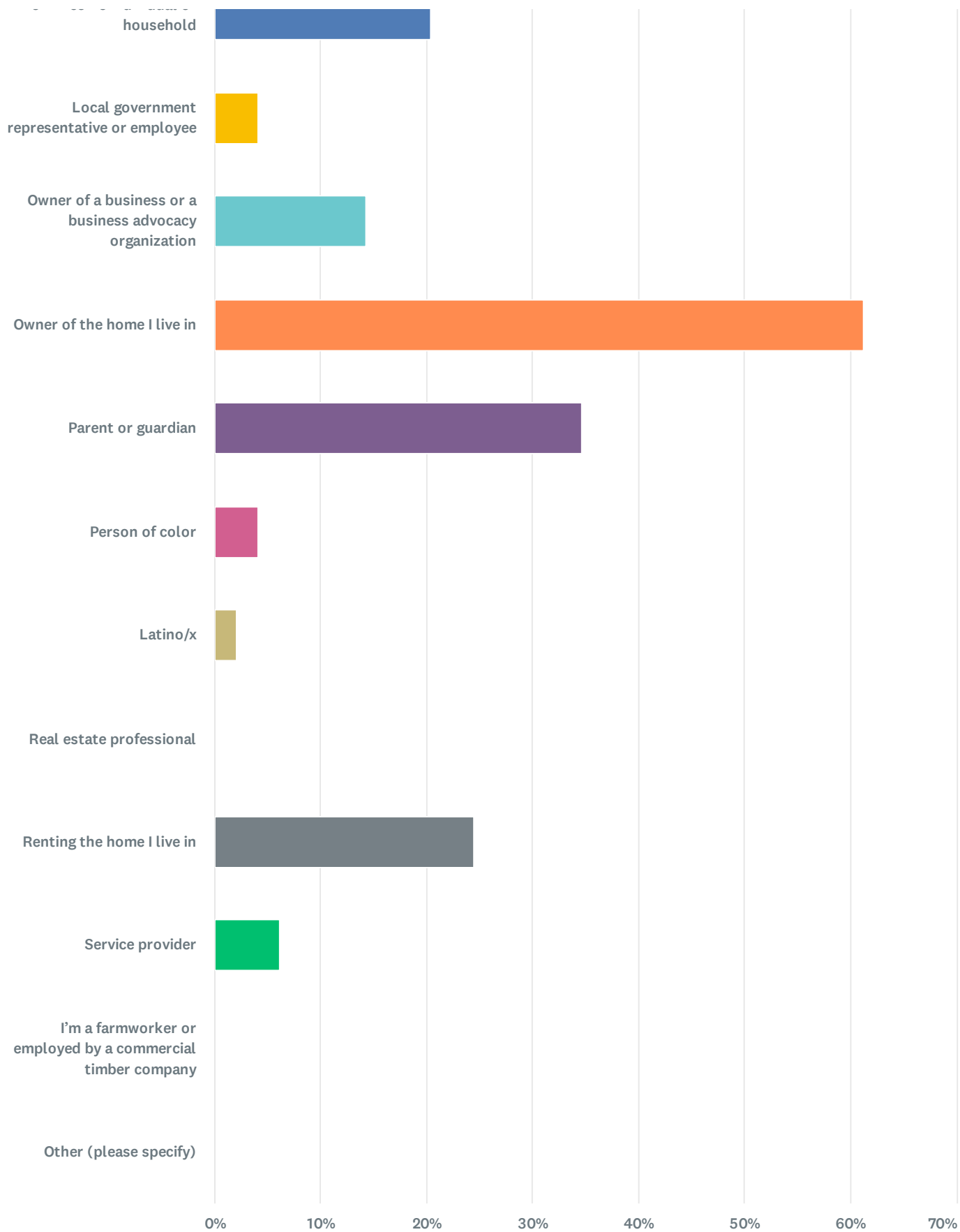
